

12 ITEMS FOR THE MAKE-UP EXAM

Question 1: Who can take the make-up exam?

Answer: Students who have the right to take the final exam (final exam) but do not take the exam or do not achieve sufficient success in the exam can take the make-up exam. However, students who fail due to absenteeism cannot take the make-up exam.

Question 2: In which cases is the make-up exam held?

Answer: The make-up exam is held on the dates specified in the academic calendar and is valid for students who have the right to take the final exam (final exam). There is no make-up exam at the end of summer school.

Question 3: How is the make-up exam grade evaluated?

Answer: The grade obtained in the make-up exam is accepted as the final exam grade and this grade is evaluated according to the decision to be taken by the instructor responsible for the execution of the exam, either absolute or relative, if the necessary conditions are met.

Question 4: Can a student who cannot take the final exam take the make-up exam directly?

Answer: Yes, students who cannot take the final exam (final exam) can take the make-up exam directly. The student does not need to make a separate application to take the make-up exam; students who cannot take the final exam can take the make-up exam directly.

Question 5: Is there a make-up exam?

Answer: No, there is no make-up exam for the make-up exam.

Question 6: I failed due to absenteeism, can I take the make-up exam?

Answer: No, students who fail due to absenteeism cannot take the make-up exam.

Question 7: In which courses is the make-up exam not applied?

Answer: The make-up exam is not applied for courses that are evaluated with studies spread throughout the semester. In addition, make-up exams are not held for courses that are determined by the relevant board decision not to have a make-up exam.

Question 8: Is there a make-up exam for courses that are excluded from the end-of-semester letter grade evaluation?

Answer: Make-up exams are not held in courses that are excluded from the final letter grade evaluation. These courses are determined by the relevant board decision.

Question 9: I got a DC or DD grade, do I have to take the make-up exam?

Answer: When you get a DC or DD grade, if your GPA is above 2.00, you are not required to take the make-up exam. After the make-up exam, if your GPA is below 2.00, your DC and DD grades will be converted to FF.

Question 10: I took a make-up exam to improve my DC or DD grade, and I got a lower grade than my final exam grade. Can I request that my final exam be valid?

Answer: No, the grade you get in the make-up exam is accepted as the final exam grade. In other words, the grade you get in the make-up exam is considered valid even if it is lower than your final exam grade, and it is not possible to request the validity of your final exam grade.

Question 11: Do I need to apply somewhere to take the make-up exam?

Answer: No, you do not need to apply separately to take the make-up exam. The make-up exam is automatically applied to you if your grade is DC, DD, FD, FF.

Question 12: Is the make-up exam paid?

Answer: No, the make-up exam is free of charge.
